

CO-DIRECTED THESIS AGREEMENT

In consideration of laws and regulations governing the co-operation between public institutions of a scientific, cultural and professional nature and other public or private organisation in Italy and abroad;

In consideration of article 4 of Italian Law no. 210 of 3.7.1998 concerning the regulations on Doctoral courses in Italy;

In consideration of Italian Ministerial Decree no. 224 of 30.4.1999 "Regulations on the Doctoral Research Program";

In consideration of the Regulations on the Doctoral Research Program of the Politecnico di Torino;

In consideration of the Regulation on the Doctoral Research Program of the Pázmány Péter Catholic University.

Between the Politecnico di Torino

with registered office in Torino, Italy, Corso Duca degli Abruzzi 24, represented by its Rector, hereinafter indicated as the Institute of Origin

and the Pázmány Péter Catholic University

with registered office in Budapest, Hungary, Szentkirályi u.28, represented by its Rector, hereinafter indicated as the Host Institution,

in view of their common intention to promote the scientific co-operation through the mobility of their doctoral students,

it is decreed as follows

I - ADMINISTRATIVE PROVISIONS

Article 1

To come into force in the Academic Year 2013/2014 and remaining in effect for a term of 3 years, a procedure of co-directed thesis is established towards András Laki, hereinafter indicated as the doctoral student, in possession of the university degree in Biomedical Engineering issued by The Politecnico di Torino and doctoral student in Electronics and Telecommunication Engineering at the Politecnico di Torino (Torino, Italy).

Article 2

The preparation of the thesis shall take place both at the Politecnico di Torino and at the Host Institution, during work stages to be conducted alternatively in Hungary and in Italy. Changes in the projected work schedule shall be granted according to the logistic needs or the opportunities arising from the development of the research activity.

Article 3

The doctoral student enrolled at the Politecnico di Torino shall also be regularly enrolled at the Host Institution, which agrees to exempt him from the payment of the enrolment fees. Under this arrangement the doctoral student shall be a student-researcher within the framework of the Doctoral Program in Electronics and Telecommunications Engineering of the Politecnico di Torino, as well as in Multidisciplinary Doctoral School at the Host Institution. His registration shall be renewed annually at the beginning of each Academic Year.

Article 4

Students from member countries of the European Union that have the European Health Card or a substitutive Statement issued by the country of origin have access to the services offered by the Italian National Health Service; for nationals of other countries outside the European Union an Italian insurance policy should be stipulated, in compliance with the immigration laws. The insurance coverage of the doctoral student's civil liabilities in Italy and in Hungary shall be guaranteed by a policy stipulated by the Institute of Origin for the totality of its students.

Article 5

As far as possible the doctoral student's accommodation shall be guaranteed by the services in charge in each country. The doctoral student shall profit from all assistance usually provided for Host Institution's students. Besides, the parties of this agreement shall undertake, as far as possible, to take action to be the doctoral student profited by financial aids from national agencies involved in the Italian-Hungarian co-operation.

II - EDUCATIONAL PROVISIONS

Article 6

The joint tutors of the thesis shall be Prof. Pierluigi Civera, of the Department of Electronics and Telecommunications at the Politecnico di Torino and Prof. Kristóf Iván, Professor in the Faculty of Information Technology at the Host Institution; they assume this responsibility in joint form in the behalf of the doctoral student.

Article 7

The Board of Examiners shall be selected by the two partner Institutions and be staffed jointly by scientific representatives from both countries. It shall include at least four members. The final examination will take place at the Host Institution.

Article 8

The thesis shall be written in English.

Article 9


The parties of this agreement undertake to grant the doctoral student, further to a sole dissertation, the title of Research Doctor released both by the Host Institution and by the Politecnico di Torino.

Article 10

The submission and any reproduction of the thesis shall be subjected to the regulations in force at the Politecnico di Torino, according to what stated at the Host Institution.

All matters not provided for in this agreement shall be governed by the Regulation on the Doctoral Research Program of the Politecnico di Torino and by the Regulations of the Host Institutions.
